• INGREDIENTS •

Each page on your website should have specific and purposeful content for that individual page.

Each page need only be one part of a dish and not the entire meal.

- Keyword Phrase
- Title
- Meta Description
- Key Concepts
- Featured Image and Helpful Images
- Internal and External Links

Identify your **Keyword Phrase** for your page.
This is your main
ingredient



Give your page a **Catchy Title** that incorporates
your Keyword Phrase.



Add a Meta Description that explains your page content in an enticing way.



Add a Featured Image with a file name that describes the photo. Add an Alt Tag that describes the photo. Add more photos only if they add value to the content.

Review your content and add links from within your content to other pages on your site and reference content from other popular posts about the same subject on the web.

• DO •

- Pick one keyword phrase to highlight per page
- Use the keyword phrase to create Title, Meta Descriptions and Content
- Use a picture and alt tags that compliment your keyword phrase
- Write as much as you can, naturally, and appropriately for the page of your site.

• DON'T •

- Start writing until you have identified your keyword phrase
- Duplicate content on any two pages
- Target a keyword that you have already targeted on another page on your site
- Use Full-Size photos Right size them before loading them
- · Keyword load your alt tags or content
